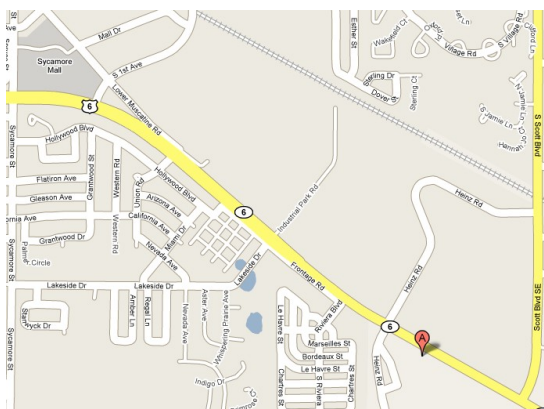

Early childhood educators have a golden opportunity to begin teaching the skills of tolerance, respect, and acceptance to young children in their care.
